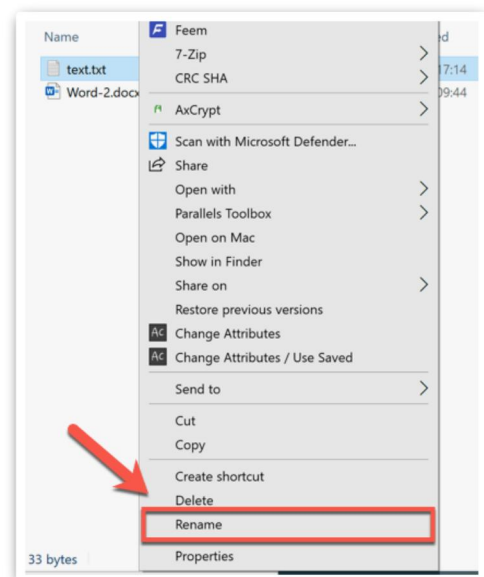


Figure 5: example of Windows interface on your laptop or desktop

A8	MUSIC & MP3 MANAGEMENT	<p>a. Categories that may need backing tracks should be saved in MP3 format only. (NOT .midi, .wav, .mpeg or .mxi)</p> <p>b. Please ensure that the music is within the permitted duration as stated in the Codes & Fees, according to the selected level. All backing tracks must be submitted in MP3 format during Submission of Entries, Appendix A1.</p>
A9	PARTICIPANT MANAGEMENT	<p>a. A participant is <u>ONLY ALLOWED maximum 2 entries</u> this year. Combination is permissible but please ensure that they are not in the same grade of same instrument. <i>Example: a student named Jane Lo participates in Grade 1 Classical Piano (CG1) + Elementary Piano Duet (EEP) is allowed. Another student participates in Grade 2 Modern Piano (MG2) + Solo Dance is allowed.</i></p> <p>b. A participant cannot enter twice in the same category and level, unless it is of different music period, instrument or dance. <i>Example: RG1 + RG1, even though different pieces, is not allowed.</i></p> <p>c. A participant re-entering the same category and level, which s/he has won a GOLD in the past, will be disqualified with no refund.</p> <p>d. Any amendment of participant's name spelling will be charged MYR100 after submission.</p>

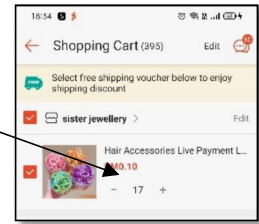
BOK Category Timeline:
